Myanmar Medical Association is the only registered professional Medical Organization in Myanmar and is founded since 1949. Presently they are 17,000 members. Main organization comprise of 30 specialist societies, 5 special interest to with over 80 branches, all over the country.

Activities during 2009–2012, consist of Academic Conferences, provision of continue medical education and including distance learning system.

Concerning the public health project quality diagnostic and standard treatment of Malaria project reached population of nearly 38,000. TB private public makes Dots Program reach 10,909 persons, sexual reproductive health and minimal initial service package provision covered 18,820 mothers. Emergency Life saving Ambulance Service in collaboration with well wishes was established in October, 2012.

Social activities include performing religious ceremonies for Buddhist and Christian members, paying homage to the elderly doctors above 73 years of age, attending the old and infirm senior doctors by the Support Group of Elderly Doctors. Sports activities comprise the monthly Golf Tournament, Russian Pool competition bi-annually and various sports events during the Annual Conferences.

Myanmar Medical Association undertakes

the above primary health care projects as well as reproductive health services in close collaboration with UN agencies like UNFPA, UNICEF, WHO, UNOPS, UNAIDS. And INGO like PSI, World Vision, MDM, Care Myanmar, GRGA and Nippon Foundation also with local NGO like MRCS, MMCWA and Myanmar Pharmaceutical and Medical Equipment Entrepreneurs Association.

As for the international relationship Myanmar Medical Association is the member of Medical Association of Southeast Asian Nation since 1997, confederation Medical Association of Asia and Oceania (CMAAO) since 2009 and became the member of the World Medical Association (WMA) in 2012.

As for the way forward Myanmar Medical Association is extending the provision of primary health care services to the outreach population including the ethnic minorities. Our Association in coordination with Myanmar Medical Council and Myanmar Academy of Medical Sciences is proceeding to establish an accreditation system in renewing of licensing for medical practice in the country.

Myanmar Medical Association is also taking a leading row in the formation of Medical Protection Society for Myanmar.
